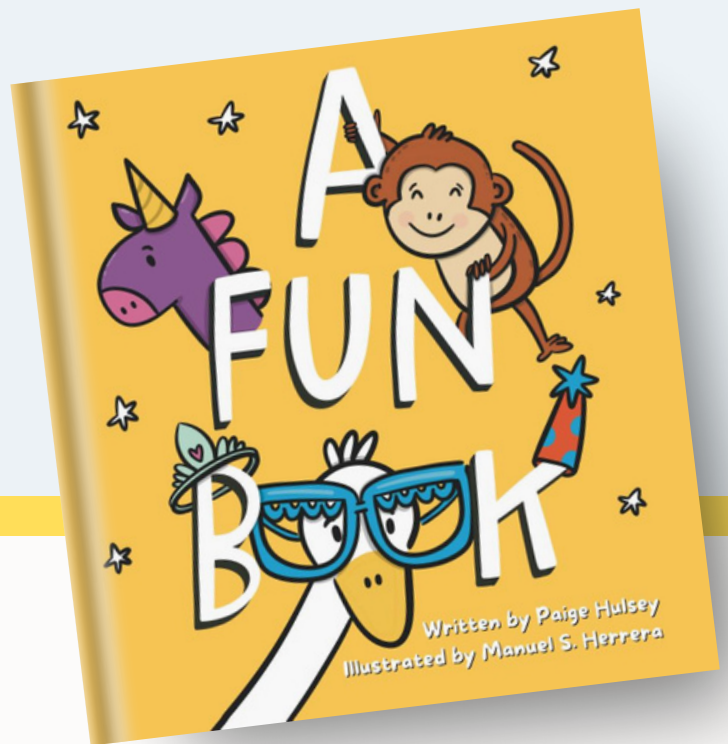


A Fun Book
